Price Increase - School Dinners

It is with much regret that we will need to increase the price of a school dinner from **£2.50** per day to **£2.60** per day from 6th September as we are unable to absorb all of the increasing costs. This still represents good value for money and mirrors other schools in the area.

School Uniform

School uniform for the 22/23 academic year will remain the same. Please ensure your child has the correct uniform, PE kit and footwear. There are several children wearing brightly coloured pairs of shoes and trainers at the moment. This is sometimes understandable at this time of the year especially as the weather is so hot and children's feet grow at inopportune times. However please ensure your child returns to school in September in plain black shoes. (Trainers are acceptable so long as they are **plain black** and have no logos on them.)

PE kit will also remain the same for 22/23. However, now that concerns around covid infection have passed, from September children will be expected to bring their PE kit to school in a bag and get changed for PE lessons as they did prior to the pandemic (other than in Nursery and Reception).

We have also had a number of children trying to take part in PE lessons with earrings in – this is a health and safety issue. Children should be able to remove their earrings for PE and either hand them to their teacher for safe-keeping or leave them at home on PE days.

Children with long hair should have their hair fastened up on PE days.

Absences in term-time

In our mission to catch-up from the after-effects of Covid it is even more important that your children attend school regularly.
